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## Horoscopes

In this imaginative teaching activity, students create horoscopes for their classmates using the modal verb 'will' to talk about predictions.

Before class, make one copy of the worksheet for each pair of students.

### Procedure

Begin the activity by asking the students about their zodiac signs. See if the students can remember all the signs of the zodiac, and ask if the students ever read their stars.

Next, divide the students into pairs and give each pair a copy of the worksheet.

Explain that they are going to write short horoscopes for all the signs of the Zodiac with predictions for the following day or weekend.

Go through how to make predictions using the modal verb 'will'.

Give students some ideas for predictions to write about, e.g. health, money, family, friends, free time, love, luck and travel.

When everyone has finished writing, display the students' horoscopes on the classroom wall.

Working individually, students go round the classroom, reading the predictions for their signs and making notes about the predictions.

After the day or weekend, students re-read their notes about the predictions. Students then tell the class about which predictions were true.

Students then vote for the most accurate horoscope in the class.
